MP (3) 1 Gartland's Arcot Indecision, 8 month s/w, balanced head with moulded foreface, lovely eye shape & placement, neat ears all combining to get a sweet expression. Good length of neck, level topline good bend of stifle & gentle sweep over loins. Nicely rounded bone & neat feet. Both front & rear angulation was good & so moved well. In good coat well presented, all in all a promising puppy; 2 Daniels & Taylor's Pepperhill Cruise Control, 7 months nicely broken b/m, balanced head with good ears for a blue. Lovely flowing lines, well rounded bone, nicely constructed on the front & rear & so moved well. Well presented, another promising youngest; 3 Stafford's Rannerdale The Entertainer, P (7.1a) 1 Robinson's Lavika Luminary, 10 month s/w, lovely moulded head with well placed eye & neat ears giving a sweet expression. Lovely rounded bone, straight front, good length of neck, level topline with gentle sweep over loins, good bend of stifle. Nicely constructed & moved well. Overall a lovely puppy who will do well. BPD, BP; 2 Stafford's Rannerdale Rentaghost, 7 months, another lovely puppy & unlucky to come up against 1 who because of his age has the advantage of being a little more finished in coat. Lovely balanced head with good eye & ear placement giving a sweet expression, good length of neck, good bone, nicely constructed, good bend of stifle & moved nicely around the ring. Well presented, one to look out for; 3 Gartland's Arcot Indecision. J (5) 1 Edwards' Castlerose Star Turn, tri, nicely proportioned head, good ears & nice eye placement. Good length of neck, nicely rounded bone, nicely constructed front & rear & so moved well. Level topline, nicely fitting jet black jacket; 2 Hepburn's Shellamoyed Simply The Best, s/w, nice head & expression, ears a little heavy, good neck length, nice topline, well made youngster with good bone & moved nicely, in good coat which was well presented; 3 Gray's Shenachie Minstrel Boy. Y (7) 1 Jackson's Shellamoyed The Kingsman, s/w, nicely proportioned head, good eye, neat ears which he used well, pleasing expression, round bone, sufficient length of neck, level topline, not in huge coat but nicely presented. Moved well front & rear; 2 Sangster's Amethrickeh Storm Wizard, b/m, not a showing fool in fact I think he would like to be anywhere but the show ring, but used them enough to get a fleeting glimpse of his expression. Good head proportions & eye shape, good length of neck with a flowing outline, well constructed front & rear & so moved well. In good coat, nicely presented; 3 Walker's Legacy De Moorstyle, M (5) 1 A Indecision; 2 Goodwin's Highbrook He's Got Style, s/w from puppy class. Good head with pleasing expression, good eye placement & neat ears, well boned, nice length of neck, good angulation front & rear & so moved well, in good coat; 3 Daniels & Taylor's Pepperhill Cruise Control. N (2,1) 1 A Indecision. G (7) 1 S Simply The Best; 2 Edgar's Ellenyorn Echo Beach, shaded s/w, nice proportioned head, good with pleasing expression. Sufficient length of neck, level topline in good coat well presented. Nicely made & moved well; 3 A Storm Wizard. PG (3) 1 Mottram's Midday Sun at Lochkaren, s/w, lovely balanced head with good shaped eyes, neat ears giving a sweet expression, good length of neck, nicely angulated front & rear, good topline with a gentle sweep over croup. Straight front with lovely rounded bone, moved well. Presentation immaculate, looked to be just coming back into coat; 2 Hill's Tegensastrakan at Molson, shaded sable, balanced head with good eye & neat ears which he used. Well rounded bone, level topline, good bend of stifle, nicely constructed & moved around the ring well. In good coat well presented; 3 McCourt's Conorvean Tonkin, L (8) 1 Goodwin's Sandwick Turn Back Time at Highbrook, not an overly glamourous tri but has a nicely fitting jacket of jet black which was well presented, nice balanced head, good eye & neat ears, lovely length of neck, level topline. Nice rounded bone & neat feet, good bend of stifle. Well angulated both front & rear & moved well; 2 Gatheral's Herds Humphrey, s/w, another nicely made dog, good balanced head with nice eye shape & good ear placement giving a pleasing expression, Good bone, nice topline, good bend of stifle. Looked to be just coming back into coat which was nicely presented. Nicely made on both front & rear & so moved well; 3 Hay's Degallo The Gambler. O (9) 1 Nixon's Nor Ch Japaro Designed In Time, golden s/w. Lovely balanced head, good eye shape & neat ears giving a sweet expression. Good length of neck, flowing outline level topline, gentle sweep over loin, good bend of stifle. Nicely constructed front & rear so moved well. In good coat immaculately presented; 2 Gartland's Arcot Time To Remember, shaded sable, nice head proportions, good eye shape, neat ears giving a sweet expression, looks to be just coming back into coat but well presented. Pleasing outline, good bone, nicely constructed both front & rear & moved nicely. Not a showing fool but did enough to show his expression & outline; 3 Walker's Dippersmoor Star Gazer by Tooralie. V (6) 1 Stafford's Ch Rannerdale Bugsy Malone, shaded s/w. Lovely head & expression, nice ears, good neck length, level topline, good sweep over loins, nice bend of stifle, well rounded bone. Nicely angulated & moved well both ways & showed non-stop. Lovely overall dog in good coat that showed off his lovely outline. RCC; 2 Rutterford's Blue Ranger of Neraklee, b/m, not in the coat of 1 but a nice fitting jacket of good colour. Good head shape, nice length of neck, good topline, nicely constructed front & rear, moved well, good overall substance; 3 Smith's Orean Top Gun. S/w (10,3) 1 Goodwin's Ch Highbrook Hot Heir, s/w, nicely balanced throughout, lovely proportioned head with neat ears, good eye shape giving a pleasing expression, nice length of neck, good round bone, level topline

good bend of stifle, well angulated front & rear & so moved well. In good coat nicely presented, a non-stop showman; 2 Pattinson's Kyleburn Acis, shaded s/w, have judged this dog on a few occasions, nicely balanced throughout. Lovely refined head, good length of neck, flowing outline, good construction both front & rear & so moved well, today just not quite the coat & finishing's of 1 such a frustrating boy not overly keen on showing but does enough; 3 McLiquham's Muirieston Prince Charming. Tri, b/w, b/t (4) 1 Main's Shenachie Night Jar, in good coat of lovely jet black, nicely balanced head with good eye & neat ears giving a good expression for a tri. Lovely bone, good length of neck, level topline & gently sweep of loin, well angulated front & rear, moved with ease around the ring. Nicely balanced throughout; 2 Walker's Marsula Shogun, jet black coat, nice head shape, good expression, lovely outline, good bone, nice flowing outline, well constructed front & rear, just unlucky to come up against 1; 3 Sangster's Drumcauchlie Two Tone. B/m (3) 1 Rutterford's Ch Kelgrove Just Blue at Stormhead, nicely broken blue, balanced wedge shaped head, good eye, neat ears which he used nonstop. Nicely arched neck of good length, straight front of well rounded bone, level topline & good bend of stifle. Well angulated on both front & rear & showed in his sound movement. Lovely overall picture, pleased to award him the CC & RBIS; 2 Edwards' Castlerose Spiritmaster, nicely coloured b/m. Balanced head, good length of neck, well rounded bone, good outline & in good coat well presented. Nicely constructed front & rear & moved with ease around the ring; 3 Sangster's Amethrickeh Storm Wizard. Breeders (1) 1 Saunders' Torriglen Trainblazer, only one in class, nice head shape, good length of neck, good bone, level topline, good bend of stifle. Good coat immaculately presented. Moved nicely. NBBE (7,2) 1 Ch K Just Blue at S; 2 A Storm Wizard; 3 S Minstrel Boy.

BIS with the agreement of my co-judge, Miss Bartholomew was **Pepperhills Kicks 'N' Flicks;** RBIS, Ch Kelgrove Just Blue at Stormhead; BP, Lavika Luminary; & BVIS, Ch Molson Moet Chandon.

MP (4) 1 Fisher's Shellamoyed Heavenly Charm, charming she certainly was, delightful 81/2 month tri with jet black coat & good tan markings. She has a pleasing head pattern with well placed & shaped eye, straight front, good layback of shoulder, level topline & well angulated hindquarters. A very confident showgirl who moved & showed well. BPB; 2 Forbes' Wellneuk Dancing Flame, 7 months s/s of lovely size & shape. She has the correct wedge shaped head, flat skull, rounded muzzle & neat ears. She has a good reach of neck, correct shoulder angulation & well let down hocks. Presented in superb condition with good muscletone which reflected in her strong movement. Just preferred the expression of 1; 3 Stafford's Rannerdale Queen O'the North. P (5,1a) 1 S Heavenly Charm; 2 Walker's Tooralie's Matilda, 11 month tri of much appeal. She has a well balanced head, good foreface, correct dark eye, well rounded muzzle, well carried ears all combining to give a sweet expression. She is a pleasing overall shape with the correct amount of bone & good body proportions. I am sure she will change places with 1 on other occasions. Such a shame she was disturbed by the surroundings today; 3 Jackson's Rowancrest Moonlight Dream. J (3,1) 1 Mottram's Lanteague Stage Whisper at Lochkaren, feminine g/s/w with correct wedge shaped head, dark eye, clean stop & good eye & ear placement. She has a well arched neck & level topline, good bone & strong hindquarters. She was well presented in good coat & condition but she was very bothered by the overhead fans & this reflected in her movement; 2 Purves' Donallin Ultimate Magic, s/w, size larger than 1 but still within the Standard. Pleasing overall shape, balanced head, good forehand angulation & depth of chest, level topline & good sweep over the loin, moved soundly on good legs & feet. Presented in good coat & condition. Y (11,4) Lovely class. 1 Parkes' Milesend Sweet Whispers, very feminine s/w of correct shape & size. She has a well balanced head with melting expression, well placed dark almond shaped eye, good stop & well rounded foreface. She has a lovely reach of neck, correct shoulder angulation, level topline & well let down hocks. Moved well as her construction would suggest; 2 Nixon's Japaro Touch The Stars, nicely constructed s/w of much appeal. Her head is balanced with flat skull, dark eye & neat ears all combining to give desired expression. She is well constructed fore & aft with good bone. A very attentive showgirl who moved & showed well. Close decision between 1 & 2; 3 Robinson's Lavika Lucky Star. M (3,1) 1 S Heavenly Charm; 2 Stafford's Rannerdale Queen O'the North, 7 months old s/w of lovely make & shape, very true to type. She has a pleasing head pattern with kind well placed & shaped eye, straight front, good layback of shoulder, level topline & well angulated hindquarters. Such a pity her ears were playing up today as she is

another lovely puppy who should have a bright future. N (6,3) 1 w Dancing Flame; 2 R Queen O'the North; 3 Edwards' Castlerose Clairvoyant. G (8,2) 1 Robinson's Lavika Good Luck, litter sister of 3rd in Y, g/s of lovely size & shape. She has a good head with flat skull, correctly placed almond shaped eye & neat ears but slightly lacked underjaw. She has a good length of neck into well placed shoulder & upper arm, level topline & good bend of stifle. Immaculately presented in super coat & condition; 2 Fisher's Shellamoyed Babycham, s/w with much quality. Lovely size, shape & substance. Her head is balanced with good underjaw & well placed neat ears which she used well. She has good shoulder & upper arm assembly, level topline, strong hindquarters & well let down hocks. She was a very attentive showgirl who moved & showed well. Just preferred the expression of 1; 3 Elder's Ellenyorn Echo Falls. **PG** (5,1) 1 Latimer's Sonymer Liquid Gold, s/w of excellent type in profuse well maintained coat of correct texture. She has a pleasing head pattern with flat skull, well placed dark eye & neat ears. She is well angulated fore & aft with good depth of chest & spring of rib. She moved with purpose & was well presented; 2 Lycett's Herds Hallicia at Iliad, s/w of good size & substance. Typical sheltie head with smooth rounded foreface, correct stop, flat skull, dark eye, good underjaw & neat ears. She has a good length of neck into well placed shoulder & upper arm, level topline & good bend of stifle. Alert showgirl who moved soundly: 3 Wyper's Murieston Classic Design, L (8.1) 1 Hill's Molson Midori Sunset, glamorous s/w with much to like about her. She has lovely head properties with good foreface, dark eye & well carried ears all combining to give a sweet expression. She has a nice arched neck, straight front, level back, good depth of chest & well angulated hindquarters. She moved freely on good legs & feet & was well presented as always by this exhibitor; 2 Fisher's Shellamoyed My Blue Heaven, pretty b/m who appealed for her colour, size & shape. She has a balanced head with flat skull, correct stop & well placed & shaped eye, good shoulder & upper arm assembly, level topline & strong hindquarters. Notice she is the mother of my puppy winner so just coming back into full coat; 3 Wilkie's Avonbank Wish Upon A Star. O (8) Lovely class. 1 Latimer's Sonymer Summers Gold, eyecatching s/w who is nicely constructed with correct wedge shaped head, well filled foreface, lean flat skull, well placed dark eye & neat ears. She has correct shoulder & upper arm construction with good depth of chest, spring of rib, level topline with good sweep over the loin & well let down hocks. She moved freely with ease & was well presented in lovely coat & condition; 2 Forbes' Wellneuk Dancing Waters, rich dark sable of different type to 1. Well constructed from tip to toe with wedge shaped head, correct dark eye, clean stop & well carried ears. She has a lovely reach of neck into well placed shoulder & upper arm, level topline & strong hindquarters. Her superb construction enabled her to move soundly around the ring with drive & purpose & she was presented in immaculate condition; 3 Lycett's Herds Hallicia at Iliad. V (3) 1 Nixon's Ch Japaro Designed In Dreams, very glamorous s/w now in her 10th year. She is a lovely size & shape with balanced head, good foreface & underjaw, correct stop, well placed & shaped dark eye & neat ears all combining to give a very sweet expression. She is well constructed front & rear with a good bend of stifle & the longest tail of the day! She moved & showed well & was clearly enjoying her day out; 2 Hill's Ch Molson Miguila Sunrise, very pretty s/w in her 8th year. She too is a lovely size & shape with lovely head properties & like 1 is very well made. She moved really well with drive from the rear & was presented in super coat & condition. Another worthy champion, it was really splitting hairs between them. Thank you for bringing them today; 3 East's Jacquard Heaven Can Wait, in fabulous condition, a credit to her owner. Sp O – S/W (6,3) 1 Deveson's Lucky Liaison at Lianbray, shaded s/w now in her 7th year. Her head is well balanced with good foreface, correct dark eye & well carried ears which she used all the time. She has a good shoulder & upper arm placement, level topline & well let down hocks, good bone & neat feet. She moved with animation & this won her the class. Faultless presentation; 2 Fisher's Ch Shellamoyed Simply Gold, glamorous s/w slightly longer cast than 1. She is a pleasing overall shape with wedge shaped balanced head, flat skull, dark almond shaped eye & lovely ear carriage. She has an arched neck with good angulation front & rear, level topline, good sweep over the loin & very good bend of stifle. Moved & showed well. A worthy champion; 3 Wilson's Rannerdale High Society at Dasgeda. B/M (4,1) 1 Daniels & Taylor's Pepperhill Kicks 'N' Flicks, have admired this lovely bitch from the ringside. She is a super clear silvery blue colour with a lovely wedge shaped head, lean flat skull, correct stop, good foreface & well carried ears. She has excellent front angulation, super reach of neck, level topline & slope over the croup. Her shape is complemented by well angulated muscular hindquarters enabling her to move with good front extension & drive from the rear. She was an attentive showgirl at one with her handler today & I was delighted to award her her 3rd CC. With the agreement of my co-judge Miss Bartholomew, she was BIS. Very well done; 2 Main's Shenachie Snowberry, well balanced bitch of pleasing shape & size. She has a lean refined wedge shaped head with flat skull, correct stop & good fill of foreface. She has a good reach of neck, level topline & correct sweep over the loin. Moved soundly on good legs & feet. Little reluctant to use her ears today but was well presented to get the best from her; 3 Sangster's Drumcauchlie Harmonise. BBE (2) 1 Hill's Ch Molson Moet Chandon, s/w now in her 8th year who stood out for her elegant shape, outline & very sweet expression. She is feminine all through with a well balanced head proudly held on a long neck & well laid shoulder. She has a straight front, level back, low set tail & strong hindquarters. Her movement was smooth & graceful & she was presented in lovely coat of correct texture & hard condition. Another worthy champion. RCC, BVB, BVIS, well done; 2 Sangster's Drumcauchlie Harmonise, b/m of good size & shape. She has a

wedge shaped head with flat skull & dark eye but would prefer better ear placement. She had a good depth of body & spring of rib, level topline & correct sweep over the croup. Very attentive to her handler, she moved with good front extension but was a little close behind today. **NBBE** (2) 1 Deveson's Janetstown Je Suis, very glamorous g/s who, in my opinion, has blossomed over the past year. She is a lovely size & a very pleasing shape. Her head is correct with flat skull, good almond shaped eye & neat correctly placed ears which all combine to give her a sweet feminine expression. She has a good reach of neck, is well angulated fore & aft & has a super long tail. She moved well as her construction would suggest & held her topline on the move. She was shown in profuse coat of correct texture & was expertly presented. A strong contender for top honours, I am sure her time will come; 2 Wyper's Murieston Classic Design, s/w of good size & shape. She has a nicely balanced head with correct eye placement & neat ears which she used nonstop, but slightly lacks underjaw. She has a good reach of neck, level topline & sweep over the loin, straight well fitting coat presented in good order. Moving a little close behind today.
